

Fees and Charges (from August 2018)

The sexual and reproductive health services provided at FPT are available to anyone.

FPT recognises a core group of patients who are able to access our services at no out-of-pocket expense.

Core Patient to FPT

- Health Care/Pension Cardholders
- Disability Cardholders
- Under 25s
- Aboriginal/Torres Strait Islanders

Fees are applicable to all other clients (non-core).

Non-Core or Private patients to FPT

Your financial contribution supports FPT's valuable service to the local community.

- All consultations will incur an out-of-pocket expense of \$20
- Annual administration fee of \$35
- Some consults may have a consumable item This incurs an additional cost that will not be claimable through Medicare
- Financial support may be available for those under 25 years of age through the Youth Health Fund (YHF)
- For those over 25 years of age and on a concession card, financial support may be available through Women's Health Tasmania Fund (WHF)

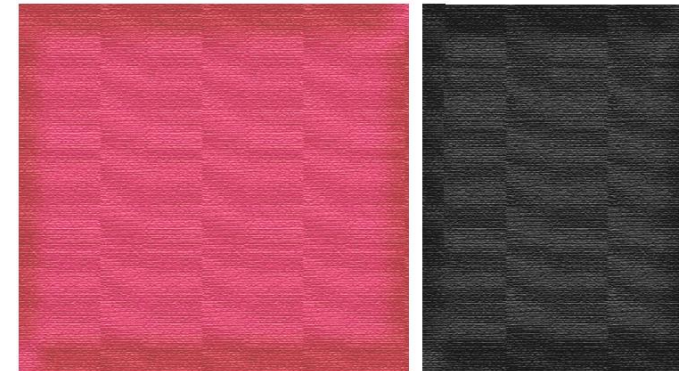

Our clinics operate in Glenorchy, Launceston and Burnie and through a number of outreach services.

Contraceptive Services

Talk with a Family Planning Tasmania clinician to choose a method of contraception that suits you.

Contraceptive services include:

- Counselling and advice
- Contraceptive implant insertion/removal
- Depo injections
- Contraceptive Pill
- Emergency contraception
- IUD insertion/removal



Pregnancy testing, counselling and referral

FPT clinicians provide supportive, non-directive, non-judgmental pregnancy counselling.

Information provided to clients with an unplanned pregnancy includes:

- Becoming a parent
- Adoption
- FPT provides medication termination of pregnancy (MToP) and provides assisted referral for surgical termination of pregnancy (SToP)

Sexually Transmissible Infections (STIs)

FPT offers screening and treatment for common Sexually Transmissible Infections (STIs) such as Chlamydia.

In most cases screening involves a simple urine test or a self-obtained swab.

FPT can assist clients to notify partners.

We also provide free condoms to reduce the risk of catching or transmitting STIs.

Sexual Counselling

FPT provides information, treatment and referral for a number of sexuality and sexual health concerns including:

- Sexual assault
- Sexuality
- Sexual and relationship issues
- Sexual dysfunction
- Painful sex

Other Women's Health Services

We provide assessment and management of a range of women's health conditions including:

- Abnormal bleeding / discharge
- Menopause
- Period problems
- Fertility
- Early pregnancy assessment and referral
- Vulval disorders
- Continence issues
- Pelvic pain
- PCOS

CST is the new Pap!

Pap smears have been replaced by a new Cervical Screening Test (CST).

This change is good news for women and means that they will need to have fewer tests.

The new test will also improve early detection of cervical cancer and save lives.

If you have a cervix, have ever had sex with a man or a woman, and are 25 years or older it is recommended that you have a regular CST every 5 years.

No matter what age you are or how long ago your last pap/CST was, if you are having abnormal bleeding you need to see your healthcare professional or make an appointment at FPT.
