The sexual and reproductive health services provided at FPT are available to everyone.

### Health Care, Disability, and Pension Cardholders

Your consultation will be bulk-billed on presentation of a current **Concession AND Medicare card**.

### Under 21s

Your consultation will be bulk-billed on presentation of a current **Medicare card**.

For all clients over 21 and not on a concession card there is an out of pocket (gap) cost for your appointment and any procedures.

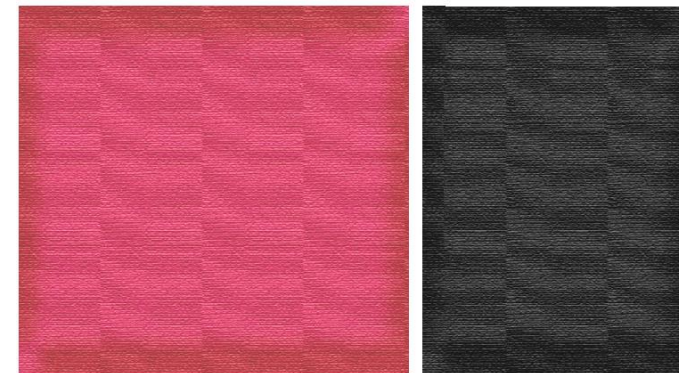

## Why FPT?

Family Planning Tasmanian (FPT) provides specialist sexual, reproductive and women's health services.

Our services are designed for everyone in our community and are non-judgmental and supportive.

Appointments are confidential; we do not share information with My Health Record.

You can find our clinics in Glenorchy, Launceston and Burnie, as well as via a number of outreach services.

## Our services

### Contraception

Services we provide include:

- Discuss a method of contraception that suits you with our expert clinicians.
- Contraceptive implant insertion/removal
- IUD insertion/removal
- Depo injections
- Contraceptive Pill
- Emergency contraception
- Vasectomy and tubal ligation referral
- Diaphragm insertion



### Pregnancy testing

We offer pregnancy testing along with support and other services during pregnancy.

### Pregnancy counselling and referral

We provide supportive, non-directive, non-judgmental pregnancy counselling.

If you have an unplanned pregnancy, we can discuss:

- Becoming a parent
- Adoption
- Termination/abortion

We provide medication termination of pregnancy (MToP) and assisted referral for surgical termination of pregnancy (SToP).

### Sexually Transmissible Infections (STIs)

FPT offers screening and treatment for common Sexually Transmissible Infections (STIs) such as Chlamydia and Herpes.

Regular testing is recommended in under 30s, whether or not you have symptoms. In most cases, screening involves a simple urine test or a self-obtained swab.

We also offer blood tests for HIV, Hep B, Hep C and Syphilis.

We provide free condoms to reduce the risk of catching or transmitting STIs.

### Women's Health Services

We help women of all ages manage their health, offering assessment and management of a range of conditions, including:

- Cervical Screening Tests
- Period problems
- Vaginal symptoms such as itching, discharge or bleeding
- Common gynaecological problems
- Polycystic Ovarian Syndrome
- Endometriosis
- Miscarriage
- Fertility concerns and investigation
- Pregnancy planning checks
- Early pregnancy care
- Pelvic pain
- Premenstrual symptoms
- Breast problems
- Menopause
- Pelvic floor, prolapse and continence

### Sexual Counselling

FPT provides information, treatment and referral for a number of sexuality and sexual health concerns including:

- Sexual assault
- Sexuality
- Sexual and relationship issues
- Sexual dysfunction
- Painful sex
- Male sexual health including erectile dysfunction
